The overall responsibility for safety at any CYM activity or event lies with the CYM Executive Committee or the organising group of any event or activity CYM has been invited to take part in.

The responsibility for implementation of this statement lies with the CYM Executive Committee.

In support of this policy the CYM Trustees, as Health and Safety Officers, will report to the Executive Committee on any health and safety matters at each meeting.

Health and Safety will be a standard item on the Agenda of each CYM Executive Committee Meeting.

A generic Risk Assessment has been prepared, which will apply to the majority of events and activities involving CYM members and volunteers. Should this not be adequate or applicable to any event or activity a specific Risk Assessment will be undertaken.

This statement will be reviewed by CYM Executive Committee in January of each year and will be updated and amended as necessary, if so required. This statement should be re-validated annually as appropriate.
